



Meal Plans






- If you are staying on campus it is mandatory that you have the Platinum meal plan.
- This plan has a cost of \$2,671.92 per semester and \$5,343.84 annually.
- For the fall semester and spring semester a student that is staying on campus will have to pay \$12,207.84 without tax.
